ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 1st day of February, 1950

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section thirty-one of the Municipal Corporations Amendment Act, 1948, and section one hundred and twentyfive of the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby authorize the Glen Eden Town Board to permit the laying-off of the proposed street described in the Schedule hereto at a width for part of its length of less than sixty-six feet, but not less than fifty feet, subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land shown edged green on the plan marked P.W.D. 130693, referred to in the said Schedule within a distance of forty-eight feet from the centre-line of the said street

SCHEDULE.

THAT proposed street in the North Auckland Land District, Town District of Glen Eden, containing by admeasurement 1 acre 11 perches, more or less, being part of Allotment 1.47, Parish of Waikomiti . As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 130693, deposited in the office of the Minister of Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured red .
