Flooding

Exposure Zones

New Zealand Standard 3604:2011E classifies all properties in New Zealand into zones based on environmental features including wind, earthquake, snow load and exposure. These zones are relevant to building requirements, such as strength of buildings, materials that should be used and maintenance. All building sites are classified as being in Exposure Zones Extreme Sea Spray, B, C, or D, depending on the severity of exposure to wind driven salt.

This property is classified as: Unknown or Unassessed Corrosion Zone

Unknown or unassessed - No known information is available relating to these sites. Recommended that specific sites and/or product designed and to consult suppliers information for specific durability requirements.

Coastal Erosion

This explanation appears on all LIMs, not just sites that may be susceptible to coastal erosion.

The map entitled "Natural Hazards - Coastal Erosion" shows information on potential coastal erosion and resulting land instability, if any, in relation to this site.

Coastal erosion is the wearing away of land due to coastal processes such as waves and currents. Coastal instability is the movement of land (typically as a landslide) resulting from the loss of support caused by coastal erosion.

Where applicable, the map shows lines that indicate areas susceptible to coastal instability and erosion (ASCIE) within the next 100 years. The lines do not show the future position of the coast. Rather, they show the landward edge of the area that might become unstable as a result of coastal erosion. The area between this line and the sea is considered to be potentially susceptible to erosion, or instability caused by erosion.

The lines represent three timescales, and take into account projected sea level rise based on carbon emission scenarios known as representative concentration pathways (RCP):

- 2050 (0.28 m of sea level rise; RCP 8.5)
- 2080 (0.55 m of sea level rise; RCP 8.5)
- 2130 (1.18 m of sea level rise; RCP 8.5)
- 2130 (1.52 m of sea level rise; RCP 8.5+)

The RCP projections are from the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change fifth assessment report (2015), and the related sea level rise values align with Ministry for the Environment Coastal Hazards and Climate Change Guidance for Local Government (2017).

The lines are based on data from a regional study ("Predicting Auckland's Exposure to Coastal Instability and Erosion", available on the Council website). The lines may not take into account local variability, and are not intended for site-specific use.

Development on sites affected by potential coastal erosion may be subject to Auckland Unitary Plan activity controls and may require a detailed coastal hazard assessment report to be completed by a qualified expert.

11.0 DECISION

Pursuant to Sections 93, 94, 94A – 94D, 104, 104C and 108 of the Resource Management Act 1991, being satisfied that no body or person is adversely affected, **consent is granted** to the application by Jennifer Mary Harris for a proposed new dwelling with earthworks, outdoor space and driveway infringements (as more accurately defined in Sections 3 and 4 of this report) at 5A Atkinson Road, TITIRANGI being LOT 2 DP 145867 for the following reasons pursuant to Section 113 of the RMA:

- (i) The adverse effects on the environment will be no more than minor because the design and scale of development would be appropriate and consistent with the surrounding neighbourhood, would not cause detriment to road safety, adversely affect nearby residential amenity or detract from the character and appearance of the surrounding area.
- (ii) Actual and potential effects on the environment are considered to be no more than minor and will be adequately avoided, remedied or mitigated by the conditions of consent.
- (iii) The proposal has been considered in terms of the relevant assessment criteria, meets the relevant policies and objectives of the District Plan and would create no more than minor adverse effects on the environment.

Conditions imposed on the consent are as follows:

- 1. The development shall proceed in accordance with the plans titled entitled "Proposed house for Jenny Harris, 5a Atkinson Road" by Location Homes Ltd and dated 12/12/07 and 12/02/08 pages 1-5 and all referenced by Council as LUC 2007-2231 and the information, including further information, submitted with the application.
- 2. A consent compliance monitoring fee of \$702.00 (inclusive of G.S.T.) has been paid to the Council. This fee is to recover the actual and reasonable costs incurred ensuring compliance with the conditions of this consent. If on inspection, all conditions have not been satisfactorily met, a reinspection shall be required at the relevant hourly rate applicable at the time of reinspection.
- 3. Pursuant to section 125 of the Resource Management Act 1991, this consent shall lapse after a period of five (5) after the commencement of the consent.
- 4. Before commencement of any works and until completion of exposed site works, adequate sediment and erosion control measures shall be constructed and maintained by the consent holder. The consent holder shall notify Council's Monitoring Officer when controls are in place. Work shall not commence until approval has been gained in writing from the Manager Resource Consents. The control measures must be maintained until the site has been adequately stabilised against erosion and sediment-laden run off. The construction and maintenance shall be in accordance with the Erosion/Sediment Control Measures Appendix to the Natural Area rules of the Waitakere City Council District Plan.
- 5. A Licensed Cadastral Surveyor shall set out the foundations of the proposed structure and certify to Council in writing prior to work progressing beyond the foundation stage that the building will comply with the Height and Height in Relation to Boundary rules of the District Plan if constructed in accordance with the approved consent in terms of levels and position. No work shall proceed beyond this stage until receipt of such certification, to the satisfaction of the Manager Resource Consents

And

A Licensed Cadastral Surveyor shall certify to Council in writing prior to work progressing beyond the pre-lining stage that the building will comply with the Height and Height in Relation to Boundary rules of the District Plan if constructed in accordance with the approved consent in terms of levels and position. No work shall proceed beyond this stage until receipt of such certification, to the satisfaction of the Manager Resource Consents.

- 6. The applicant shall employ a suitably qualified independent arborist with proven experience in dealing with trees in relation to construction (works arborist) to monitor, direct and supervise all works within the dripline of protected vegetation for the duration of the development.
- 7. Prior to works commencing, a meeting shall be arranged by the consent holder so that the tree protection procedures are explained by the works arborist to all contractors, sub-contractors and work site supervisory staff who are carrying out any works associated with the project within the dripline of any protected vegetation.
- 8. A protective fence shall be erected to the extent of the dripline of the protected Pohutukawa located adjacent to the northern end of the eastern site boundary. The protective fence shall be of solid construction style, such as Rent-a-Fence or wooden panelling
- 9. A protective fence shall be erected 1.5 metres from the trunk(s) of the protected Grisilinea located adjacent to the western site boundary. The protective fence shall be of solid construction style, such as Rent-a-Fence or wooden panelling.
- 10. No more than 20% of the existing canopy of the protected Grisilinea shall be removed. All works shall be undertaken in accordance with accepted arboricultural practice.
- 11. No storage of materials, cement/concrete washings, leaching of chemicals, storage or tracking of machinery, or stockpiling of spoil shall occur within those areas demarcated by a temporary protective fence. The temporary protective fences shall remain in place throughout the duration of the construction works.
- 12. All tree roots of retained protected vegetation, measuring 40mm or greater in diameter, exposed during the course of excavation works, are to be retained, carefully worked around and protected. All roots less than 50mm diameter exposed in the course of excavation works, shall be pruned back cleanly, using a sharp saw or a pair of secateurs past any point of fracture or damage. All retained and or cut roots shall be protected from drying out by a covering of hessian or similar material that is to be kept damp until the excavated area can be backfilled.
- 13. In any instance where the above condition cannot be met, approval for the removal of tree roots measuring 40mm or greater in diameter located within the dripline of any protected vegetation shall be obtained from the Works Arborist prior to works commencing or continuing. The arborist may carry out the removal of such roots only when he/she is satisfied that the health and safety of the subject vegetation will not be compromised.
- 14. Within the planting season (typically Apr Sept) immediately following the proposed tree removal the applicant shall plant within the site, four appropriately selected replacement native trees from the following list of PB Grade* 40 or equivalent shall be planted in a suitable location on site. It shall be the responsibility of the resource consent holder to provide evidence of this replacement planting to Council's Environmental Monitoring Officer in the form of

an invoice or similar if called upon to do so.

[*This is a horticultural term referring to the pint bag size the tree has been grown in. A tree nursery or garden centre will be able to advise you with respect to fulfilling the outlined requirements].

- a. Pohutukawa (Metrosideros excelsa)
- b. Kanuka (Kunzea ericoides)
- c. Titoki (Alectryon excelsus)
- d. Kowhai (Sophora microphylla)
- e. Mahoe (Melicytus ramiflorus)
- f. Narrow Leaved Lacebark (Hoheria angustifolia)
- g. Totara (Podocarpus totara)
- 15. The replacement trees shall be of good quality nursery stock and maintained to the satisfaction of Council for a period of 2 years from the date of planting. Any of the replacement trees which die within the stated period shall be replaced and maintained as per the stated conditions.
- 16. The trees shall be mound planted with a maximum height of half the root ball above ground level. An appropriate planting medium shall be mounded up around the root ball and secured in place with a quality, well-rotted compost or mulch spread around the newly planted trees. This mulch shall be spread no shallower than 50mm and no deeper than 150mm. Any of the replacement trees which die within the stated period shall be replaced.
- 17. The development shall proceed in accordance with the recommendations and conclusions of the geotechnical report entitled "Proposed house for Jenny Harris, 5a Atkinson Road" by Tower Foundation Design.
